Things that you should check once you think you're done making your Qualtrics survey:
Consent form  Do you have one?  Did you update the estimated time of survey completion?  Did you require response (or in some other way make sure participants have to agree to consent or exit the survey)?
Extra features  Do you have a field to capture Prolific ID?  Do you have a CAPTCHA?  Do you have an attention check?
<ul> <li>Timing</li> <li>For any longer questions, did you add question timing?</li> <li>Is it working correctly?</li> <li>If you have an open-ended question, are you setting any time or text-entry limits on what can be entered?</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Text formatting</li> <li>Are your fonts and text sizing the same across questions?</li> <li>Do you need to <b>bold</b> anything?</li> <li>When previewing the survey, is the entire question and answer choices visible without scrolling?</li> </ul>
Blocks  Are your blocks named in a way that someone else looking at your survey could easily figure out what's in them?  Are they all in the correct order in survey flow?  If you have between-participants conditions, did you set separate embedded data fields for each one in the survey flow?  And did you randomize the order of presenting each embedded data option?  And set it to present only one of them?  If you have multiple conditions (especially between-participants), is the question wording identical across them?
<ul> <li>Making your survey analysis-ready</li> <li>Does every question have a question label?</li> <li>And if you were to upload your data publicly, could someone else figure out what each question corresponds to based on your question label?</li> <li>Are your answer values recoded and named?</li> </ul>

Study design  Are your blocks properly randomized or counterbalanced?  Are you "evenly presenting elements" in the survey flow randomizer?  Are your questions within blocks properly randomized?  Are your answer choices properly randomized?  Did you "request response" for all non-demographic questions?  If you have a slider question, did you set the midpoint (or other relevant option) as the default starting position?
Look and feel  ☐ Does it matter if your survey has the Princeton logo? If so, remove it in look and flow ☐ Do you have a progress bar at the top of the page with verbose text?
